Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, Cemetery Directory *Price* \$15; *Members* \$11.25. Family, church, and commercial cemeteries, both past and present with address and phone number (when available). Reference is made to the location and availability of records. Softbound, 76 pages

Atlas of the City of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 1911

Price \$20; Members \$15. In 1906, Allegheny City was annexed to Pittsburgh and two years later the pattern of wards was modified, and many street names were changed because of duplication. Maps show both old and new names of streets. This is a necessary tool for census and city directory research. Oversize, wire bound, 50 pages

Deaths in the Pennsylvania Bituminous Coal Districts, 1888-1897, Vol. I. Price \$20; Members \$15. A summary of the annually published reports made to the Mine Inspector by the Superintendent of every coal mine in the western bituminous counties of Pennsylvania for the years 1888 through 1897. Entries include the deceased's name, date of accident and death, location of accident, occupation, and age. Most include marital status and the number of children. Coil bound; 124 pages; map; bibliography; indexed.

Deaths in the PA Bituminous Coal Districts, 1898 – 1901 Volume II. *Price \$20; Members \$15.* A summary of the annually published reports to the Mine Inspector by the Superintendent of every coal mine in the western bituminous counties of Pennsylvania for the years 1898 through 1901. Entries include name, date of the accident and/or death, location of the accident, occupation, age, marital status, and the number of children. Beginning in 1900, nationalities are listed. Also, for some fatalities, alternative spellings of names, nationalities (prior to 1900), accident details, any coroner's inquest findings, etc. Coil bound, 236 pages, map, bibliography, indexed.

Fires in Allegheny City, Pennsylvania, 1875-1907 *Price \$20; Members \$15.* Names of 6,000 owners, along with the date and time of the fire, plus location, structure type, and cause of the fire. Softbound, 345 pages.

Marriage Returns, City of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, 1870-1875.

This three-volume set lists over 14,000 names from marriages performed by ministers, aldermen, and justices of the peace in Pittsburgh from 1870-1875. Alphabetical by groom plus an index to brides, softbound.

Index to the Registration of Deaths Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, 1893-1905.

These volumes do <u>not</u> include deaths in Pittsburgh, Allegheny City, McKeesport, or Sewickley.) They are the result of an act in 1893 requiring assessors of the townships, boroughs, and wards to record deaths within their district. It does include the name of the deceased, the date and place of death, and the document number. With this document number, you can request a copy of the entire entry page from WPGS. There are four separate volumes available:

- Surnames A-F (140 pages)
- Surnames G-Mc (151 pages)
- Surnames ME-SP (125 pages)
- Surnames SR-Z (76 pages).
